Constitution

1. **Name**

The club shall be known as 'Berwick Rangers FC Supporters' Club'.

2. **Objects**

- (a) To assist and promote the welfare and best interests of the Berwick Rangers Football Club.
- (b) To promote social functions and other ways of raising money, which shall be used to benefit Berwick rangers FC in such ways as are deemed necessary by the Supporters' Club.

3. **Membership**

Membership of the Supporters' Club shall be open to any person who contributes the annual membership fee.

4. **Officials**

- (a) The officials of the Supporters' Club shall be: Hon. President, Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Secretary, Treasurers and a Committee of no more than 14 members.
- (b) One official and four committee members will retire annually, but will be eligible for a re-election.
- (c) In the event of a vacancy through resignation, the Committee have the powers of filling temporarily such a vacancy until the next Annual General Meeting.
- (d) No person or persons involved or connected with the BRFC Board of Directors or an outside body or person with a vested interest in BRFC can become a member of the BRFCSC Committee without being specially nominated by a member and then invited by the Committee to join the Committee to assist with running the BRFCSC. The person or persons must be voted on at the AGM or EGM as appropriate.

5. **Finance**

- (a) All monies belonging to the Supporters' Club shall be lodged in the bank under the name of the Berwick Rangers FC Supporters' Club.
- (b) The Treasurer shall keep correct accounts and books, showing the financial affairs of the Supporters' Club, and shall produce same for examination on demand by the Committee, and at the Annual General Meeting shall submit a full and complete statement, duly audited, of the income etc. of the Supporters' Club for the preceding year.
- (c) The accounts of the Supporters' Club shall be brought to balance on the 30th April of each year and shall be audited by an accountant, who shall be annually elected.

6. **The Annual General Meeting**

- (a) At which the audited accounts shall be presented, shall be held no later than 30th June in each year: notice of the same to be given in the press a minimum of 14 days before the date of the meeting.
- (b) No amendments to this constitution can be made at other than the Annual General meeting or Special Meetings. Such amendments, if approved, shall be operative as from the date of such meeting. Notice of motion for the proposed amendments of the constitution must be in the hands of the Secretary, in writing, not later than seven days before the advertised date of the Annual General Meeting.
